Round 2 of the "Pirelli North of England Enduro Championship" SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

This is a **Regional Restricted** event for solo motorcycles, held under the National Sporting Code and Enduro standing regulations of the Auto Cycle Union, together with these supplementary regulations along with the "Final Instructions" which will be issued.

BASIC INSURANCE

LOCATION - Will be at Langdale Forest. Signposted from A170 Pickering to Scarborough road in Thornton-Le-Dale then via the main Dalby forest drive.

THE START - Will be at 10.30 am, with 3 or 4 riders setting off every minute.

THE ROUTE - The course will consist of forest going, fire breaks and fire roads. The lap length will be approximately 20 miles.

SPECIAL TEST - There will be 1 special test per lap, of a cross country nature, untimed on the first lap for sighting.

RE-FUELLING - Must only take place in the designated area (between the green flags). Crews must provide a fire extinguisher. No smoking in this area.

TIME CHECKS - These will be marked with white flags 200 meters before the check and yellow flags 20 meters before the check (do not cross the yellow flags before your designated time).

BLUE TAPED AREAS - These have a compulsory walking pace speed limit. **NONE COMPLIANCE WILL RESULT IN EXCLUSION.**

LICENCES - Competition Licence number must be provided on application, and presented at Signing on. Day licences are available, if required this must be specified on Entry Form.

SIGNING ON – Will commence from 8.30 am. All riders and marshals must sign on at event control.

MACHINE EXAMINATIONS - **Lights must be fitted, No MX bikes!** Will take place between 08.45 and 10.00 hrs, you must have your machine in the park ferme by 10.00 Riders only permitted in the Park Ferme. Your machine will be checked for the usual including noise level. It is your responsibility to ensure you comply with the Noise Regulations. Numbers and plates must be fitted to the front and both sides.

MARSHALLS - Be polite to marshals and officials at all times. Remember they have all volunteered to provide a days riding for you.

CATERING – A catering van will be in attendance near the start area

LITTER – Please take all litter home with you. Also goggle Roll offs can be used but *Tear offs are not permitted* they do not degrade and cause hazard to wild animals.

ACCOMODATION & CAMPING - facilities are available in the area. Contact local tourist information on www.ryedale.gov.uk. **NO CAMPING IN LANGDALE FOREST!**

E-MAIL – You can opt to have your Entry Confirmation and Final instructions sent by e-mail. Just put it on your entry form and don't bother with envelopes. ***Beware - If you have not received an e-mail confirmation then you will not get Final Instructions or an entry! Make sure you legibly write the correct address down.***

ENTRIES - Are open to members of clubs affiliated to the Auto Cycle Union. Entry fees will not be refunded, unless entry is refused or the event is abandoned (£3 may be retained). All entries to be on an official entry form together with the appropriate **fee** and 2 **S.A.E.**'s to the secretary of the meeting (see above) by no later than 5th May 2008. Entries will be limited to the first 180 received with fully completed entry form and cheque made payable to **"RYEDALE MOTORCYCLE CLUB LTD."** Either 2 stamped & addressed envelopes (9X4 min size) or e-mail address on entry form **OTHERWISE NO ENTRY. Your entry has not been accepted if you do not receive a confirmation by post or e-mail within 2 weeks.**

INSURANCE – The organizers have chosen to use **Basic Insurance** cover for this event. The main difference is **NO** personal accident cover for competitors, previously there was limited cover for this. Please ensure if you require personal accident cover you **MUST** make your own arrangements, contact the ACU for details of annual policies.

LATE ARRIVAL ALLOWANCE – Please note this has been removed from the ACU handbook.
