This round of the North of England Enduro Championship is held under the National Sporting Code and Standing Enduro Regulations of the A.C.U. together with these supplementary regulations and any final instructions which may be issued.

**Eligibility**

This is a Regional Restricted event and entry is open to any rider who is a member of an ACU affiliated club in the Yorkshire, East Yorkshire or North East Centres. Riders who are not members of any such club are invited to join the Yorkshire Enduro Club – see entry form for details

**ENTRIES**

Entries must be made on an official entry form (or photo copy). They can be found on the web site: [www.enduro-neec.org.uk](http://www.enduro-neec.org.uk) [www.enduroneews.com](http://www.enduroneews.com) and should be returned to the secretary of the event together with the appropriate fee.

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt until the event is full (up to a maximum of 180). Entries will be placed in ability class order only. Within each ability class, riders will start in order of receipt of entry, regardless of capacity class (so to be first away, enter quickly!)

The closing date for entries is 5th September 2009. Should the event have to be cancelled owing to any reason beyond the control of the organisers, £10 will be retained by the club to cover expenses and the remainder of the entry fee refunded. Please note that the entry fee will not be refunded under any other circumstances.

**Nature of the event:**

The event is a true Enduro, consisting of several laps of Forestry Commission land in the Cropton Forest complex. Competitors will be required to ride to a specified time schedule and will be awarded penalty points for early or late arrival at check points. Competitors will also ride a cross-country special test where they will be timed to the nearest second. Additional penalty points will be added for breach of regulations specified in the Enduro Standing Regulations.

**Signing on:**

Before presenting their machines for examination, all competitors must sign on with the Secretary of the meeting.

**Machine examination:**

Motorcycles: the responsibility is on the rider to ensure his/her motorcycle complies with all legal requirements. **All motorcycles must be fitted with working lights.**

**Motorcross bikes are NOT permitted in this event.**

Competitors will be checked at the start of the event to ensure their machines and clothing comply with regulations. Helmets must bear a stamp complying with the **current** gold or silver ACU stamp. **Helmets bearing the old 1.5mm wide bordered stamp will not be acceptable.** Machines must comply with ESR 11 and the ACU technical specification. The stroke dimension of the engine must be marked on the outside of the flywheel/generator cover. A noise test will be carried out during the event. Any machine exceeding 94 dBA will be excluded from the event.

**Tyres**

Any type of tyre used must be enduro type to current FIM specifications to comply with ACU Enduro regulations .

Number plates must be fitted to the front and both sides and must be coloured as follows:

- Championship ~ Red plate with white numbers to the front; black on yellow to the sides.
- Expert ~ Green plate with white numbers to the front; black on yellow to the sides.
- Clubman ~ Yellow plates with black numbers to front and sides.
- Sportsman/Trail ~ Black plate with white numbers to the front; black on yellow to sides.

All plates must be supplied and fitted by the competitor.

**General:**

All service crews must possess a fire extinguisher which must be to hand at all times when a competitor is refuelling. Failure to comply with this essential safety rule may result in the exclusion of associated rider(s).
